Olive Hill Historical Society

In the late 1990's, several prominent citizens of Olive Hill, KY purchased the historical structure known as Olive Hill High School for the purpose of preserving the building and with the hope of converting it to use as a community center. The 1.5 acre site and 24,000 square foot building is located on a hill overlooking the small town of Olive Hill.

With resources raised from donations and state grants, the historical society was able to complete a substantial restoration program for the gymnasium and roof replacement. The organization has continued to improve the building primarily using state grants and budget appropriations.

Our Vision

Community Center: The stage and remarkable day lighting through restored 1920 era palladium windows allows for a variety of building uses from teaching to performances. Public forums, citizen assemblies, and social use keep this area well used.

Performing Arts: The youngest to the oldest residents have opportunities to perform or be entertained by this new venue by local talent while offering growth of that talent.

Heritage Cultural Center: With a love of music and a long history of performing artists in the area, the building provides a center for the heritage and culture of the area. The building offers venues for quilting, antique shows, local arts and crafts, bazaars and fairs, dancing performances and classes, with areas set aside for the preservation of local historical cooking and other life skills allowing future generations to better understand common history and cultural heritage.

Community Education: Once recognized as the center for the town's education of its children, new programs are being implemented as well to meet the needs of adults as well as children.

Personal Development: A major planned use of the restored building will be in the area of personal life skills development and the very practical teaching to allow residents to live responsibly and care for their family.

Local History & Culture: A gallery showcasing local photography from the town's history, the former school's history, and artifacts tell the story of the town from its inception. Areas showing the impact on the community of roadways and railroads are included. Seminars, various programs, and exhibits allow the children of the present and future generations to develop an understanding of earlier times and a different way of life.
